## Program Description

This voluntary program is designed primarily for people interested or involved in health care clinical education, including clinical instructors / supervisors, coordinators of clinical education at the facility, coordinators of clinical education in academic programs (eg. Internship coordinators, field-work coordinators) and academic faculty, and is recognized by the American Physical Therapy Association (APTA) as a Clinical Instructor (CI) Education and Credentialing Program (CIECP).

This program is divided in to two distinct parts:

1.) CI education via an interactive didactic course format that is appropriate to all clinical educators,

And

2.) Assessment (credentialing) of curricular outcomes through a six-station Assessment Center that is available only to physical therapists and physical therapists and physical therapist assistants.

The interactive didactic component is designed to provide knowledge and skills that are essential for all clinical educators when supervising learners. Only Credentialed Clinical trainers recognized by APTA can conduct CIECPs.

## The CI Education Program addresses issues of:

- Planning and preparing for students during their clinical education experiences.
- Developing learning experiences in practice tailored to meet specific student needs.
- Support ongoing learning through questions and effective feedback.
- Identifying and managing students with difficult and / or exceptional situations, and
- Identifying legal, legislative, and regulatory implications for clinical educators, including issues presented by ADA, HIPAA, and Medicare.

## Eligibility Criteria

### Requirements include:

- Current license / registration / certification in the clinical educator's respective discipline;
- A minimum of one year of clinical experience or comparable experience;

AND

- Completion of the Participant Dossier attesting to clinical competence within the respective discipline in accordance with state laws and regulations as authorized by the individual's direct supervisor.
